Customized Treatment Designed for Individuals

- ASSESSMENT/DIAGNOSIS/EVALUATION
- **RESPITE CARE**—Children with severe behavioral problems come to the center part-time and participate in skill-based activities
- MENTAL HEALTH IN THE SCHOOLS—Individual and community support services provided in a child's school
- ENHANCED OUTPATIENT—Intensive individual, group and family therapies using various evidence-based models
- COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY SUPPORT—Coordinate and provide services and resources necessary for independent functioning in the community
- BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT—Providing behavioral training, direction and support to the child and their family in the home and/or in the school
- TRANSITIONAL LIVING—Residential and family settings where youth gain skills necessary to live independently
- TREATMENT FOSTER CARE—Community-based 24-hour treatment in homes of specially trained parents for youth with mental health/behavioral issues
